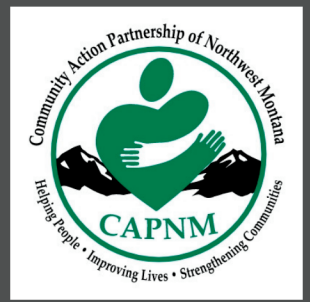

Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP),
& Weatherization Application

To apply for LIHEAP this application must be completed and returned to your local eligibility office. LIHEAP heat assistance applications will **NOT** be accepted after April 30, 2024. However, you can apply for Weatherization all year. LIHEAP and Weatherization benefits are only for the dwelling you live in at the time of application. If you move any time after applying, please contact your LIHEAP/Weatherization office.

Increasing affordable housing in Lincoln County

The project is intended to create multifamily units, with income targeting for households below 50% and 60% of the area median income. There will be 10 2-bedroom and 14 one-bedroom units in 12 duplex buildings with monthly rent ranging from 20 to 25 percent below market rates. This is the first time tax credits have been awarded for family projects in the Libby area.
