Application for Energy Share of MT

Energy Share of Montana is a nonprofit organization whose main purpose is to help Montanans facing loss of heat or electricity in their home and have no other means to resolve the crisis.



To apply for Energy Share, you need to be facing a “**crisis**” that, without intervention, would cause you to be without heat or electricity. **You MUST have one of these situations:**

- A **Past due** or **Disconnect** notice or **Less than 2 weeks’ credit** on a Flex or Pre-pay meter
- Need for a **Deposit** to establish an **Electricity or Natural gas** account in your name
- Less than **15% Propane** or **5” of Heating Oil** in tank, or less than **2-3 Bottles of Propane**
- Less than **1/2 cord of Wood** or **5 bags of Pellets**.

You MUST ALSO APPLY for LIHEAP, if applying for Energy Share during September - April.

Items that MUST be included with this application:

- ✓ Your most recent **Past due/Disconnect notice**, even if your service has already been terminated.
- ✓ If you’re asking for help with a **Deposit** to establish an **Electricity or Natural gas** account in your name, you must provide a statement from your vendor of what needs to be paid (deposit amount, past due balance, fee, etc.).
- ✓ If you’re asking for help with **Propane or Heating Oil**, include the amount currently in your tank, size of tank and a “Letter of Service” from your Propane or Heating Oil vendor.
- ✓ If you’re asking for help with **Wood/Pellets**, include the amount you currently have (cords or bags).
- ✓ Verification of all income received within the last 30 days for all household members 18 yr & older.
- ✓ A recent, 30-day bank statement, for all accounts and explain the income source for all deposits.

We cannot consider your request for assistance unless your application is 100% complete, including all pages, all questions thoroughly answered and all required documents. Energy Share assistance is situationally, not income, based. Applications are reviewed by our local Committee on a case by case basis. Committee members and CAPNM work within Energy Share’s contractual guidelines.

Our local Energy Share Committee meetings are held on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month. The application deadline is 5pm on the Tuesday before each meeting – no exceptions.

The decision of the Local Energy Share Committee is final and cannot be appealed.
